



Second International IHOP_2002 Science Workshop

The Second International IHOP Science Workshop will be held at the Météo France International Conference Center in Toulouse, France, from June 14th to June 18th, 2004, under the auspices of CNRM (CNRS/Météo France).

For the first time the IHOP Science Workshop is scheduled over a 5-day period, with 3 full days dedicated to oral presentations within topical sessions (CI, ABL, QPF, Instrument Intercomparisons, Bores), an extended poster session, dedicated IHOP_2002 working group discussions, a panel discussion as well as presentations of upcoming convection related projects such as the UK Convective Storm Initiation project (CSIP), the German Convection Project and the African Monsoon Multidisciplinary Analysis (AMMA) Project.

To help us organize the meeting and the necessary logistics, we invite you to indicate to us as soon as possible your likely participation to the workshop by completing and returning the attached form. Please, make sure that all probable participants from your institution returns a form.

In early April, a second circular will be send to those having responded which will provide further information regarding the venue of the workshop, hotel reservations, the possibility for attending students to obtain low cost housing on the Météo France campus, and suggestions for a spouse program.

A tentative schedule is in the attached file, although session length will be adjusted to their respective number of contributions. We expect a very fruitful IHOP Science Workshop and we are looking forward to welcoming you to Toulouse next June.
