

#### Permits and clearances

- Research permit: SRE (foreign affairs ministry)
  - SCT (SENEAM, DGAC): frequencies, aircraft, balloons, profilers
  - SEDENA (Defense Ministry)
  - SEMARNAT (Environment Ministry)
- Submitted by US Embassy Science & Tech Office (includes aircraft clearances)
- Minimum of 90 days for authorization

#### Permits and clearances

- Shipping invoices for temporary importation
  - Comprehensive shipping manifest
    - Full and detailed descriptions
    - Serial number(s)
    - NO personal items (NONE) or standard office supplies (i.e. blank CD's, notebooks, pens and pencils, etc.)




#### Permits and clearance

- Temporary Import of Vehicles
  - Title and registration
  - Pay deposit
  - 6 months permit
  - The authorized operator must always drive or be in the vehicle when circulating
  - 1 hour procedure at the border or through Mexican consulates in the USA.

## Expendables

- Donations to UNAM (to be confirmed)
- Coordinated by NCAR/EOL
  - Letters of donation
  - Shipment including serial numbers
- Expendables:
  - Radiosondes (SMN, DOE, others)
  - Balloons (SMN, DOE, others)

### Power and electrical installation

- Enough power at T<sub>0</sub> and T<sub>1</sub> (400kVA), need site preparation according to needs.
  - Circuits? Amps? Voltage? Load centers? Panel boards? Power outlets? Circuit breakers? Etc.
- Power at T<sub>2</sub> but need installation and preparation according to needs
  - Circuits? Amps? Voltage? Load centers? Panel boards? Power outlets? Circuit breakers? Etc.
- Need backup power (UPS) for sites according to needs.

## Internet and communications

- Internet access at T<sub>0</sub>, T<sub>1</sub>; None at T<sub>2</sub>.
- Need to check bandwidth at T₁. Sufficient?
- Internet connections to be installed where needed at T<sub>0</sub> and T<sub>1</sub>.
- Maybe satellite internet for T<sub>2</sub>.
- PBX full at T<sub>0</sub> and T<sub>1</sub>; no phone (landline) service at T<sub>2</sub>.
- Need to contract for additional phone lines.
- Excellent cell phone signal at T<sub>0</sub>, T<sub>1</sub>; fair at T<sub>2</sub>.
- May buy pre-paid cell phones at reasonable prices.

## Working and storage space

- Rent trailers for T<sub>0</sub>, T<sub>1</sub>, and T<sub>2</sub> according to needs. (estimate of US\$ 800 to 1000 per month per trailer)
- Available work space:
  - T<sub>0</sub>: need to check; maybe rent a trailer
  - T₁: 900 ft² room. No desks, tables or chairs.
  - T<sub>2</sub>: 1,000 ft<sup>2</sup> small house. No desks, tables or chairs.
- Available storage space:
  - T<sub>0</sub>: May need to rent a trailer(s) or send to a CENICA office in Tecamachalco.
  - T<sub>1</sub>: 1,000 ft<sup>2</sup> space; maybe more
  - T<sub>2</sub>: >20,000 ft<sup>2</sup> warehouse available

## Compressed gases

- What is needed? Send details on gases needs: type, purity, consumption (frequency, rate, total)... detailed specifications!!
- 3 companies: Praxair, Aga, and Infra
  - http://www.praxair.com.mx/, http://www.aga.com.mx/, http://www.infra.com.mx/
  - need to find out prices, availability in Mexico, payment methods, and delivery times per gas type.
- Status: check regulations (civil protection)
  - T<sub>0</sub>: need to follow internal institutional rules
  - T<sub>1</sub>: need a fenced area for cylinders, outside buildings.
  - T<sub>2</sub>: enough space.

## Medical and emergency services

- Provide emergency medical information.
- Make sure your medical insurance <u>covers</u> Mexico.
- Do not eat at street vendors.
- Be responsible; follow safety and security guidelines recommended by US Embassy, UCAR Safety Officer, and Logistics (Mexico).

## Housing:

- T<sub>0</sub>: looking for a hotel close to T<sub>0</sub>
  - With shopping mall and restaurants nearby
  - Within 20 min. driving distance.

#### $T_1$ and $T_2$ :

- Zumpango Sports Complex: MXP\$ 850 per cabin
  - Cabins with one or two bedrooms for 4 to 6 people (double beds)

Status:

No phone lines

No internet access

- Use of facilities: tennis court, pool, running track...
- Need to hire a cook for the time length
- Located in a small town
- Hotel Crowne Plaza Pachuca: group rate MXP \$900 + taxes (17%)
  - Single or double
  - Internet access
  - Meeting room at Hotel if needed
  - Walking distance shopping mall, food court


## Food

- T<sub>0</sub>:
  - To make sure that you have 2 or 3 restaurants within 15 min.
     walking distance. Full meal price may vary: MXP\$ 50 150.
- T<sub>1</sub>:
  - University cafeteria
  - Convenience store (Oxxo) and supermarket < 1 mile away</li>
- T<sub>2</sub>:
  - Nearest small market: 2 miles
  - Supermarket: 15 miles (in Pachuca)
  - The small house will have a kitchen; may need a fridge and microwave.

## Transportation

- Rent buses (maybe 2) and have routes between sites (T<sub>0</sub>, T<sub>1</sub>, T<sub>2</sub>, and housing)
- Operate according to schedule
- Have an additional van and driver at each site for special trips
- Paid by participants; cost to be estimated based on transportation needs.
- Recommendation: Do not rent car for Mexico City sites!
